Yesterday I attended the Northern Beaches Athletics Carnival at Narrabeen where many of our students competed. As competitors and parents arrived, I had the privilege of watching and speaking to some of athletes training for the Invictus Games being held in Sydney in October. As you may know, these games give returned defence force personnel who have suffered physical and mental trauma the opportunity to compete in many sports as part of their recovery from PTSD and physical wounds. In what I saw and heard, it put in to perspective many of those issues that we have from day to day. It also reminded me that we should not take for granted our physical and mental wellbeing but to make the most of each day with those we love.

Congratulations to the Year 2 children who received the Sacrament of Confirmation last Saturday. In the absence of a bishop, Fr Paul administered the sacrament in a very prayerful and ritualistic manner. Thank you to the parents, sponsors and teachers who assisted in the preparation of the candidates and to Janette Davidson (Sacramental Coordinator) and Fr Paul for making the day special for all the children and families involved.

At last count, Lachlan W has managed, with your help, to raise over \$2350 for *Buy a Bale*. Last Friday he collected \$634.90 in donations. The money collected will go directly to those farmers in need.

Wednesday night's parent education session on *The Resilient Child* was very well attended with 28 parents and 3 teachers present. The feedback from Jeanie McDonnell was very positive towards our parent community. Jeanie is keen to present again with the possibility of offering the *1-2-3 Magic* program again next year. 


